

College Student Internet Setup Timeline

Your Complete 4-Week Checklist for Moving to College



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4 Weeks Before Move: Research & Planning

Research Providers

- ☐ Get exact address of dorm/apartment (building, unit number) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Check if dorm includes WiFi (contact housing office) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ If off-campus, research providers available at address - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Enter address on provider websites to check availability - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Make list of 3-5 available providers (Xfinity, Spectrum, AT&T, etc.) - MEDIUM PRIORITY


Compare Plans & Pricing

- ☐ Compare internet speeds (50-1000 Mbps options) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Compare monthly prices (\$30-80/month typical) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Check for student discounts (ask with .edu email) - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Look for no-contract plans (month-to-month flexibility) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Check installation costs (\$0-100, often free) - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Check equipment rental fees (\$10-15/month for modem/router) - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Look for promotions (first month free, gift cards, etc.) - LOW PRIORITY

Determine Your Needs

- ☐ Calculate how many roommates will share internet - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Determine if you'll game online (need 300+ Mbps) - MEDIUM PRIORITY

- ☐ Determine if you'll stream 4K video (need 200+ Mbps) - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Consider Zoom classes (need 50+ Mbps per person) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Decide on budget (\$15-25/person when split with roommates) - **HIGH PRIORITY**

Select Provider & Plan


- ☐ Choose internet provider (Xfinity, Spectrum, AT&T, etc.) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Choose internet speed plan (50-1000 Mbps) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Confirm plan has no annual contract (month-to-month) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Confirm plan has unlimited data (no caps) - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Calculate total monthly cost (internet + equipment rental) - **HIGH PRIORITY**

Coordinate with Roommates

- ☐ Discuss internet plan with roommates - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Agree on speed and budget - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Decide who will sign up for service (one person's name) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Agree on how to split monthly cost - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Set up payment method (Venmo, PayPal, etc.) - MEDIUM PRIORITY

Prepare to Order

- ☐ Have exact move-in date ready - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Have exact address ready (building, unit, zip code) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Have phone number and email ready - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Have payment method ready (credit/debit card) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Check if you need parent/guardian as co-signer - MEDIUM PRIORITY

 **Pro Tip:** Most providers don't require credit check for students. Spectrum and Xfinity are great no-credit-check options.

2 Weeks Before Move: Order Internet Service

Place Your Order


- ☐ Call provider or order online - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Provide move-in address and date - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Choose self-installation (free) or professional (\$75-100) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Schedule installation for move-in day or day after - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Ask about student discounts (mention .edu email) - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Ask about promotions (gift cards, first month free) - LOW PRIORITY
- ☐ Confirm no annual contract required - **HIGH PRIORITY**

Equipment Decisions

- ☐ Decide: rent modem/router (\$10-15/mo) or buy your own (\$50-150) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ If renting, confirm equipment is included in order - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ If buying own, research compatible modems/routers - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Order your own modem/router if buying (Amazon, Best Buy) - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Buy ethernet cables if needed for gaming/streaming (\$5-15) - LOW PRIORITY

Confirm Order Details

- ☐ Write down order confirmation number - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Save confirmation email - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Write down installation date and time window - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Write down provider support phone number - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Confirm first bill date and amount - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Set calendar reminder for installation day - **HIGH PRIORITY**

 **Pro Tip:** Self-installation saves \$75-100 and is easy. Most students can do it in 15-30 minutes following our setup guide.

1 Week Before Move: Confirm & Prepare

Confirm Installation


- ☐ Call provider to confirm installation appointment - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Verify installation date and time window - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ If self-install, confirm equipment shipment tracking - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Verify equipment will arrive before move-in day - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ If professional install, confirm someone will be home - **HIGH PRIORITY**

Prepare Apartment/Dorm

- ☐ Locate internet cable outlet (coaxial, phone, or fiber) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ If no outlet, notify provider (may need installation) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Identify central location for router placement - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Verify power outlets available near internet outlet - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Clear space for modem and router setup - MEDIUM PRIORITY

Gather Information & Tools

- ☐ Print or save setup instructions from provider - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Bookmark our internet setup guide for reference - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Have provider support number saved in phone - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Have order confirmation number accessible - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Charge laptop/phone for setup day - LOW PRIORITY

 **Pro Tip:** If equipment hasn't shipped yet, call provider immediately. Don't wait until move-in day to discover problems.

Move-In Day: Set Up Internet

Professional Installation

- ☐ Be home during installation time window - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Have ID and order confirmation ready - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Show technician where you want router placed - MEDIUM PRIORITY

- ☐ Watch technician setup (learn for troubleshooting) - LOW PRIORITY
- ☐ Test connection with technician before they leave - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Get WiFi network name and password from technician - **HIGH PRIORITY**

Self-Installation

- ☐ Unbox modem and router equipment - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Connect internet cable to modem (coaxial/phone/fiber) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Plug modem into power outlet - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Wait 2-3 minutes for modem to boot up - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Connect ethernet cable from modem to router - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Plug router into power outlet - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Wait 2-3 minutes for router to boot up - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Find WiFi name and password on router label - **HIGH PRIORITY**

Test & Connect Devices

- ☐ Connect phone to WiFi network - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Test internet by opening website - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Run speed test (Speedtest.net or Fast.com) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Connect laptop to WiFi network - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Connect gaming console/devices to WiFi - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Connect smart TV/streaming devices - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Share WiFi password with roommates - **HIGH PRIORITY**

💡 **Pro Tip:** If internet doesn't work after setup, call provider support immediately. Most issues are fixed in 5-10 minutes over the phone.

First Week After Move: Optimize & Secure

Secure Your Network

- ☐ Change default WiFi network name (SSID) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Change default WiFi password (use strong password) - **HIGH PRIORITY**

- ☐ Change router admin password - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Enable WPA3 or WPA2 security (not WEP) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Disable guest network (if not needed) - MEDIUM PRIORITY

Optimize Performance


- ☐ Place router in central location (not in corner/closet) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Elevate router (place on desk/shelf, not floor) - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Test WiFi speed in all rooms - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Use ethernet cable for gaming PC/console (if possible) - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Enable 5GHz band for faster speeds (if available) - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Update router firmware to latest version - MEDIUM PRIORITY

Manage Account & Billing

- ☐ Create online account with provider - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Set up autopay (save \$5-10/month) - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Set up paperless billing - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Download provider mobile app - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Verify first bill amount and due date - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Set calendar reminder for bill due date - MEDIUM PRIORITY

Document Everything

- ☐ Save WiFi name and password in secure location - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Save router admin login credentials - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Write down account number and customer service number - **HIGH PRIORITY**
- ☐ Take photo of equipment serial numbers - MEDIUM PRIORITY
- ☐ Keep equipment boxes (for moving out later) - LOW PRIORITY

 **Pro Tip:** Set up autopay to save \$5-10/month and never miss a payment. Most students forget to pay the first bill!

Quick Reference Summary

Timeline	Key Tasks
4 Weeks Before	Research providers, compare plans, determine needs
3 Weeks Before	Choose provider and plan, coordinate with roommates
2 Weeks Before	Order service, schedule installation, decide on equipment
1 Week Before	Confirm appointment, prepare space, gather tools
Move-In Day	Complete installation, connect devices, test speed
First Week	Secure network, optimize performance, set up billing
